

## Valuable Building Sites in Mirfield.

### **T**HE following Lots of **F R E E H O L D** **BUILDING GROUND:—**

Lot 1. All that Plot of **GROUND**, situate near the Bank, in Mirfield aforesaid, and on the southern side of the Dewsbury and Elland turnpike road, bounded on the east and south by the estate of B. Wilson, Esq., having a frontage of 33 feet to the turnpike road, and containing altogether by admeasurement 566 square yards, more or less.

Lot 2. Another Plot of **GROUND**, on the western side of Lot 1, having a frontage of 33 feet to the turnpike road, and containing altogether by admeasurement 554 square yards, more or less.

Lot 3. Another Plot of **GROUND**, on the western side of Lot 2, having a frontage of 33 feet to the turnpike road, and containing altogether by admeasurement 529 square yards, more or less.

Lot 4. Another Plot of **GROUND**, on the western side of Lot 3, having a frontage of 33 feet to the turnpike road, and containing altogether by admeasurement 522 square yards, more or less.

Lot 5. Another Plot of **GROUND**, on the northern side of the said turnpike road, opposite to Lot 4, and situate between the new and old turnpike roads, having a frontage of 40 feet to the former, and 42ft. 6in. to the latter road, and containing altogether 245 square yards, more or less.

Lot 6. Another Plot of **GROUND**, on the eastern side of Lot 5, having a frontage of 41ft. 6in. to the new road, and 42ft. 6in. to the old road, and containing altogether 211 square yards, more or less.

These lots offer superior advantages to parties wishing for convenient homesteads in the most pleasant part of Mirfield, being adjacent to the turnpike road, and within a few minutes' walk of the Mirfield railway station. There is an abundance of water easily attainable.
