

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that *on the Fourth day of April next*, application will be made to her Majesty's Justices assembled at Quarter Sessions, in and for the West Riding of the county of York, at Pontefract, in the said riding, for an ORDER for STOPPING UP, TURNING, and DIVERTING a certain PUBLIC HIGHWAY, situate at or near Ings Grove, in Doctor's-lane, in the parish of Mirfield, in the said riding, commencing at or near a certain building, used as a stable by Mrs. Ann Sharp, opposite Doctor's-fold, in Mirfield aforesaid, extending from thence in a north-eastwardly direction to a certain stake on the west side of the highway called Doctor's-lane, leading to Knowle, in Mirfield aforesaid, and is more particularly described and delineated by the letters A, by C, to B, on the map or plan, which will be lodged with the Clerk of the Peace as hereinafter mentioned, and is thereon coloured yellow, being in length one hundred and sixty-six yards or thereabouts; and in lieu thereof, and as an equivalent for the said public highway hereinbefore mentioned, it is proposed to substitute, as nearer and more commodious to the public, the strip of land hereinafter mentioned, which it is intended shall be dedicated to the use of the public, and for ever hereafter to be used as part of the public highway in the said parish of Mirfield that is to say,—commencing at the corner of the said building used as a stable, running in a northwardly direction to the said stake in Doctor's-lane, leading to Knowle, in Mirfield aforesaid, which said last-mentioned strip of land is more particularly described and delineated on the said map or plan, and is thereon coloured green, and the line or course of such intended new public highway is particularly indicated by the letters A to B on the said map or plan, and measures in length from the said letter A to B, one hundred and fifty-eight yards or thereabouts, and in width thirty feet.

And that the certificate of two Justices having viewed the same highways, lands, and premises, together with the plan of the old and proposed new highway, and with the proofs and all other necessary documents, will be lodged with the Clerk of the Peace for the said West Riding, *on the Third day of March next*.
