FATAL ACCIDENT AT MIRFIELD. — An accident occurred at Mirfield railway station, on Saturday afternoon, which resulted in the death of a guard, named Wm. Stanford, residing at Wakefield. It appears that the deceased was engaged in coupling the carriages of a luggage train, which had been run back into a siding, to allow another train to pass, which the train with which he was busied moved on unawares, and he was thrown beneath the wheels. He sustained some fearful injuries, being severely crushed about the legs and lower part of the body. He was taken to the Huddersfield Infirmary, where he died on Sunday morning, about six o'clock. An inquest will be held to-day (Tuesday.)
