INQUEST AT MIRFIELD.—On Tuesday night, an inquest was held before Mr. Taylor, coroner, at the Ship Inn, Mirfield, on view of the body of John Armitage, game-keeper to Mr. Charles Wheatley. The evidence went to show that the deceased left the above house on Saturday night last about eight o'clock to go to another hostelry in the village, but was never seen after alive, and it is presumed that he must have missed his way and fallen into the river near Shepley-bridge, his body being found there in the course of the following Monday. The jury returned a verdict of "Found drowned."
