

FATAL RAILWAY ACCIDENT AT MIRFIELD.—

Yesterday morning, William Aker, an engine-cleaner, died at the Huddersfield Infirmary in consequence of injuries he had received at Mirfield Railway Station the night before. The deceased had come from the engine-shed to Mirfield Station on Wednesday night, and was crossing the line at the time that a passenger train was advancing to the station. He was noticing this train, and was not aware that a goods train was approaching from the opposite direction. The result was that he was knocked down by the goods train, and was so dreadfully injured by the wheels that he died at Huddersfield Infirmary yesterday morning, having been removed to that institution as soon as possible after the accident. The deceased was 20 years of age, and resided at Millbridge, near Liveridge.
