FATAL ACCIDENT ON THE LANCASHIRE AND YORKshire Railway.—On Monday, an inquest was held at Bradford, on the body of George Depledge, thirty-nine years of age. The deceased was a signalman on the Lan-cashire and Yorkshire Railway. On the evening of the let instant, at Mirfield, after coupling a break van to a goods train, he imprudently exhibited a safety signal before he had got clear of the carriages. The consequence was that the train was started, and he was run over. He was afterwards removed to the Infirmary, where it was found necessary to amputate his right foot, after which he gradually sank, and died on Saturday last. The jury returned a verdict of "Accidental death."
