FATAL CODLIERY ACCIDENT.-Mr. T. Taylor held an inquest at Hopton, on Saturday, on the body of a miner-named George Armytage, who was killed while at work in Mr. C. Wheatley's Calder Colliery, on the previous day. Mr. C. Morton, the Government inspector of mines. was present. The deceased, who was twenty-three years of age, was working in a new bank, when a quantity of roof fell upon him. One of the pieces of stone was a very large one, and had to be troken before it could be moved. When extricated, the deceased was quite dead. The jury returned a verdict of "Accidentally killed."
