

NEW SUNDAY SCHOOL NEAR DEWSBURY.—

Yesterday, the foundation stone of a new Wesleyan Sunday school, to be erected at Ravensthorpe, was laid by Mr. R. Ellis, the Mayor of Dewsbury, in the presence of a large number of spectators. The building is to be erected on land adjoining the Wesleyan chapel at Ravensthorpe, and is from plans by Mr. Mallinson, architect, of Dewsbury. The cost will be about £270, and the school is intended to accommodate 300 children. Mr. Ald. Rawsthorne presented a silver trowel and a rosewood mallet to his worship on the occasion. After devotional exercises, the stone was laid by the Mayor, who afterwards made a speech, in which he alluded to the necessity for providing spiritual instruction for the young of the present and succeeding generations. The Revs. Sampson Cocks and E. Workman also addressed the assembly.
