

SHOCKING DEATH OF A CONGREGATIONAL MINISTER AT MIRFIELD.—On Saturday quite a gloom was cast over Mirfield by the death of the venerable minister, the Rev. Jas. Cameron, of Hopton, in that parish. The deceased took a relative to Mirfield railway station in a pony carriage, and on returning was thrown out. It is supposed that the animal took fright at the noise made by a passing train, and caused the accident. The deceased gentleman was found in the roadway insensible, and bearing the marks of severe injury. No time was lost in removing Mr. Cameron to his residence, and in obtaining surgical aid. He, however, gradually sank, and died on Saturday.
