

ROBBERY FROM MIRFIELD RAILWAY STATION.—

A man who gave the name of Charles Seaton, but who refused to state where he came from, was placed in the dock of the Dewsbury Police Court yesterday, on a charge of felony. The prisoner was at Mirfield Railway Station on Friday, and seeing a bundle taken out of the Bradford train and placed in a truck preparatory to being sent on to Manchester, he picked it up and walked away with it, but was apprehended soon afterwards. On being searched, it was found that he was branded in two places with the letter D, and that he bore traces of having been scourged with the cat-o'-nine-tails. Prisoner was remanded till Friday.
