A PUBLICAN HEAVILY FINED.—At the West Riding Police-court yesterday, before Mr. Ackroyd and Mr. Wm. Blakeley, Enoch Marsh, landlord of the Wilson's Arms, Mirfield, was fined £5 and costs for permitting drunkenness. On the night of August 9th, about five minutes to eleven o'clock, Police-constable Chapman and Sergeant Adams visited the defendant's house, and in the tap-room found a dozen men, four of whom were very drunk. Two of the men had been before them. There was a great deal of swearing going on in the house at the time of the officers' visit.
