SERIOUS CHARGE AGAINST A RAILWAY SERVANT AT MIRFIELD.—At the same Court, Granger Green, of Eastthorpe, Mirsield, was charged with stealing a quantity of goods in transit from Mirfield Station. Mr. Ibberson prosecuted on behalf of the company. It appeared that on the 18th inst. the prisoner was found tampering with a waggon, but he made an excuse, and went away. Suspecting him, his house was searched afterwards, and property found which had been lost in transit. The prisoner was remanded. He had been in the employ of the company for nine years, and was at present one of their locomotive stokers.
