

MIRFIELD.—On Saturday the annual distribution of prizes in connection with the Mirfield detachment of the Duke of Wellington's West Riding Regiment took place at the Town Hall, Mirfield. The report, presented by Captain Williamson, showed that the number of members enrolled since the formation of the corps was 563; passed through the ranks and retired 457, leaving the present enrolled strength 106.
