

A MINER KILLED AT MIRFIELD.—Yesterday morning about nine o'clock a pit-sinker named Robert Fone, employed at the Lee Green Colliery of Messrs. Nevin and Barraclough, was killed instantly while in the shaft. He was in the winding cage, working at the pumping apparatus, when a door in a partition above fell without any warning, and struck him on the head, fracturing his skull.
